Luke 23:26-24:12

Monday – *Read Luke 23:26-31*

- What is happening to Jesus?
- Why did Simon carry Jesus' cross?
- What does Jesus say to those in the crowd and those mourning?
- Jesus was innocent but suffered, hung on a cross and died for the sins of all mankind. Consider your relationship with Jesus. Is He your Lord and Savior?

Tuesday – *Read Luke 23:32-43*

- Who are the people mocking and making light of Jesus?
- Why are they doing this?
- How and why do some today mock and make light of Jesus?
- In what way would you share the truth of Jesus' crucifixion to a non-Christian?
- Who will you share this with this week?

Wednesday – *Read Luke 23:44-49*

- What do you think the meaning of the darkness is? The veil being torn?
- How did the centurion respond to Jesus' death?
- How did the crowd respond to Jesus' death?
- How have you responded to Jesus' death?

Thursday – *Read Luke 23:50-56*

- Who asked Pilot for Jesus' body?
- What do you think Joseph was risking by asking for Jesus' body?
- Why do you think he disregarded his position and status?
- What does this say to you about your success, position, status, etc...?

Friday – *Read Luke 24:1-12*

- What were the women planning to do as they approached the tomb?
- How do you think the women felt when they saw the empty tomb?
- What did the angels say to the women? How did they respond?
- What response did the apostles have to the women's report?
- How has the meaning of the "empty tomb" affected you?
- Who must you tell about the Resurrection?
