PRESCHOOL MINISTRY TEAMS

BIBLE STUDY TEACHING LEADER: Enlist, mentor, and encourage teaching team. Lead the class in teaching the curriculum. Establish relationships with both children and parents.

BIBLE STUDY TEACHING ASSISTANT: Assist the lead teacher in doing Bible learning activities and forming loving relationships with preschoolers and parents.

BIBLE STUDY MUSIC LEADER: Lead a classroom of children in music while communicating Biblical truths.

PRESCHOOL COACH: There are exciting leadership opportunities in the preschool ministry! This crucial position provides the opportunity to build relationships with teachers, recruit others, encourage and supervise an age level pod during one hour on the weekend.

HOSPITALITY TEAM: Greet visitors and help parents find classrooms. Make kids and parents feel welcome and comfortable. Facilitate the security and sign-in process.

OFFICE ASSISTANT: Assist office staff and resource coordinators during the week to copy and prepare materials for weekly Bible Study and other special events.

GRADE SCHOOL MINISTRY TEAMS

GRADE SCHOOL BIBLE STUDY COACH: Administrate an hourly grade level in Bible Study. Assist with recruiting grade level team. Communicate to team. Build relationships with team members, the children, and their families.

GRADE SCHOOL BIBLE STUDY GREETER: Greets visitors and helps kids and parents feel welcome in a grade level hour. Record, attend, and take head count of grade level area.

GRADE SCHOOL BIBLE STUDY WORSHIP LEADER: In coordination with Large Group Leader, the Music Worship Leader provides music as a tool for enhancing the Large Group experience for the boys and girls.

GRADE SCHOOL BIBLE STUDY SMALL GROUP LEADER: Present curriculum provided by Ministry to Grade School children ages K-5 in a small group environment of 8-10 kids. Interact with children to develop meaningful relationships with kids in group. Reflect "Christ" to kids in group. Mentor others to teach. Be able to share how to become a Christian to a child.

GRADE SCHOOL BIBLE STUDY LARGE GROUP LEADER: Presents Large Group materials, provided by Ministry, with a team approach to teaching. Props, interactive tools, and other resources provided by Ministry.

ALL STAR KIDS EMCEE: The Worship Emcee prepares and facilitates the worship hour using interactive tools, video, and creative communication.

GRADE SCHOOL SUMMER MINISTRY: Volunteers provide leadership for special events such as, Day Camp, Mini Camp, VBS, and Children's Camp. They also provide children with concentrated studies of God's Word.

ALL STAR KIDS MUSIC LEADER: Working closely with the Emcee, music leaders plan for and lead our music time during Kids Town.

ALL STAR KIDS SHEPHERD: Shepherds are volunteers who role model worship behavior for a group of K-3 graders, interacts with them, and enforces behavioral guidelines.

ALL STAR KIDS - DRAMA TEAM: Assist/participate in dramas during Kids Town Worship. Prepare for parts in drama. Advance rehearsal time needed.

ALL STAR KIDS SOUND TECHNICIAN: Run sound board during Kids Town worship. Know line-up of music and sound effects. Make sure microphones are ready for production.

CHILDREN'S MINISTRY SPECIAL EVENTS TEAM: Be a part of special events, including Fall Festival, Family Events, 4th /5th grade VBS, Pre-Teen Camp, Mini-Camp, and more.

SPECIAL NEEDS MINISTRY TEAM: Members with a big heart and lots of love for our special needs children are needed during church hour, LG hour, and special events.

YOUNG CHRISTIANS CLASS: Teach specific curriculum to children who are new Christians. Teach how to have a strong foundation with Christ, and how to grow as a Christian. Volunteer on a 5-week rotational basis to teach classes. Build relationships with children in group. Talk with parents. Pray for and with children.
